CONVENTION HIGHLIGHTS

The 4-day PAEPI Biennial Convention with the theme "*Implementation of Research-Based Extension Program Towards Attainment of MDGs Cum Policy Advocacy on Magna Carta for Extension Workers*" and 19th General Assembly on December 8-11, 2010 with Aklan State University as host and organizer, in cooperation with MAAP and PAEPI as co-organizers, is enriched with the support of two prominent keynote speakers: former CHED Commissioner **Dr. Roberto S Padua**, an International Research Awardee, for the PAEPI advocacy of Implementing a Research-based extension services program in the accomplishment of MDGs and **Hon. Cong. Eulogio "Amang" R. Magsaysay, Jr.**, AVE Party List Secretary-General, for the PAEPI Policy advocacy for "*Magna Carta for Extension Services Workers*".

CONVENTION PROGRAMS

Part 1- The Presidents' Night Program

In honor of the founder, PAEPI led by the Technological University of the Philippines (TUP) duly represented by its President Dr. Olympio V Caparas. All deserving PAEPI-ANS, BODs, past presidents and active members are recognized which is timely as it coincides with the PAEPI 20th anniversary. Signing of MOU with project partners may also take place.

Part 2 - The Opening Program

During the first day of the convention, all participants will convene at the plenary hall for the opening ceremonies and plenary sessions with the First Keynote speaker as GOH. In the afternoon, the participants will go to their respective field of interest in terms of extension services development areas:

1. Socio-welfare Development
2. Socio-economic Development
3. Infrastructure /Technology Development
4. Health/Safety and Environmental Development,

Out of 39 papers submitted, 25 full papers were short-listed as entry for the best paper category. There are 4 papers to be presented in the plenary session and 30 papers to be presented in the 4 cluster sessions. Some of the papers were also entered for the best poster contest to be posted in the exhibit area. Only one best paper will be adjudged the winner per cluster based on set PAEPI criteria of gathering at least 80 points

Paper must have followed the guidelines in its preparation based on the theme, with emphasis on what Millennium development Goals (MDGs) have been accomplished by the extension services program /practices. MDGs refer to the 8 goals and 18 targets set during the 2005 World Summit in response to the world's main development changes. Derived from the original chapters of the UN Millennium Declaration of 2001, this international development blueprint aims to reduce global poverty, hunger, diseases, illiteracy, environmental degradation and discrimination against woman in 2015.

PAEPI, through this convention, provided a venue for its members to presents/share accomplishments and for documentation and recognition of their efforts as part of "*PAEPI advocacy initiatives towards MDGs Accomplishment: A Development Intervention in terms of extension delivery*", a paper to be presented by the PAEPI President at the plenary Session.

Part 3. The PAEPI Advocacy Policy Program

Magna Carta For Extension Workers shall be presented once again to the body as supported by Hon. Cong Amang Magsaysay Jr, Guest of Honor and Keynote speaker of the day.

Part 4. The General Assembly Program

All the policies, forms, procedures shall be presented to the body for the approval of the general membership. A comprehensive PAEPI biennial report shall also be presented by the outgoing President and the financial standing of PAEPI shall be reported by the PAEPI Treasurer.

Part 5. The Closing Program.

Oath taking of new members and officers shall be officiated by the outgoing President. Awarding ceremonies also follows to recognize all the participants, paper presenters , the board of judges, committee chairs and all those who make the activity as success.
