

1st PAEPI INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE AND ^{4th} PAEPI BIENNIAL CONVENTION AND GENERAL ASSEMBLY

This report documents the activities that transpired during the First PAEPI International Conference and 4th PAEPI Biennial Convention and General Assembly at the Pamantasan ng Lungsod ng Pasig (PLP) on December 1-3, 2014. The conference's theme of "Implementation of Research-Based Extension Program Towards Attainment of ASEAN 2015 Integration cum Sharing of PAEPI Best Practices" was rightly achieved with the paper presentations and theme of discussions by the foreign and local guest speakers as well as the paper presenters from various colleges and universities.

DAY 1. December 1, 2014 (Monday)

The registration started at 7:30 AM with the Secretariat composed of PAEPI Treasurer Dr. Elizabeth Joson (Bataan Peninsula State University (BPSU)), PAEPI Coordinator Dr. Reneliza Ferrer (University of Makati (UM)), Ms. Monaliza Rodriguez (BPSU), and Janice Vergara (Maritime Academy of Asia and the Pacific (MAAP)). The group was assisted by PLP students who helped with the registration and ushering the participants and guests to the venue.









The conference started at 10:00 am with the acknowledgement of the presence of the international guest speakers. This was immediately followed by the first Plenary Session moderated by Dr. James Loreto C. Piscos (PAEPI Vice President from San Beda College Manila) and judged by the foreign guest speakers. Two paper were presented: (1) Awareness among Soon-to-be-Married Couples on Vital Component Pregnancy: A Basis for the Development of a Teaching Package [Socio-Welfare Development Area] by Prof. Iluminada T. Vierne of PLP, and; (2) Leaving the Ivory Tower and Theorizing from Below: Lessons from Adopting a Participatory Grassroots Approach in Empowering Communities [Socio-economic Development Area] by Maria Isabel L. de la Hostria, Aurora E. Araojo, and Marilyn B. Panti of Catanduanes State University. After each presentation, the audience and judges were given a chance to ask questions for clarification or give comments or feedback.

The Opening Ceremony was started with a doxology and rendition of national anthems of the Philippines and USA by the PLP Himig Chorale. 


