A 45-page detailed proceedings/report about the Manila Command Seminar has been submitted to the NI London in February 2015. A summary report was published in the March 2015 Seaways issue. The Manila Command Seminar had presented the views of key maritime stakeholders on Filipino navigational competence that they perceived had contributed to the development of programme, projects and regulations to ensure professional advancement of seafarers and enhance productivity in the industry.
