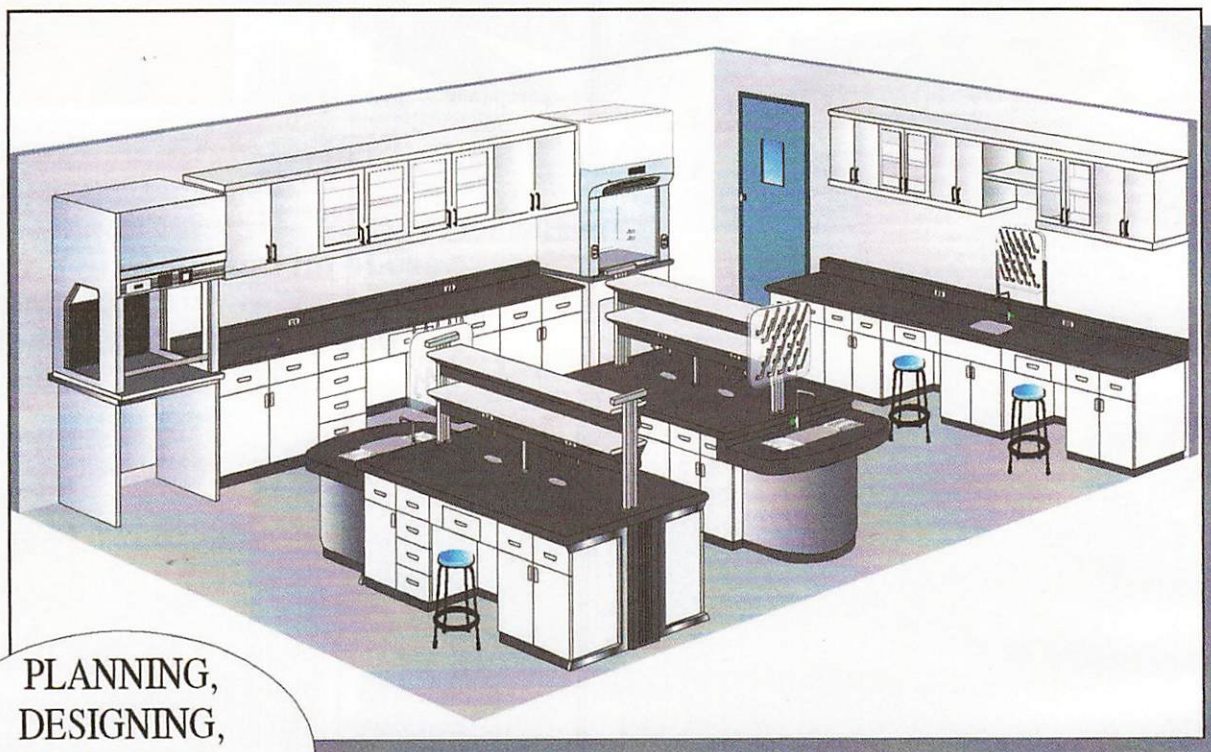

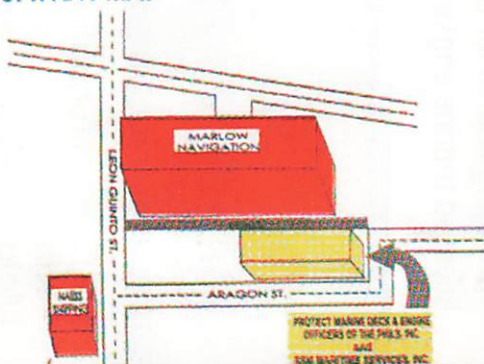

LOCATION MAP



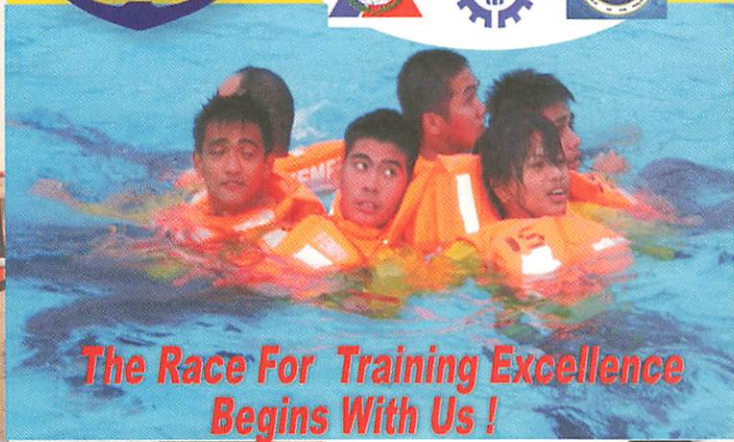
