MAAP wins best in physical facilities

The Maritime Academy of Asia and the Pacific (MAAP) was proclaimed the best in physical facilities nationwide as part of the Best Student Services Program conducted by the Commission on Higher Education (CHED) during the National Awarding Ceremony at the University of the Philippines -Diliman, Quezon City last April 17, 2009

MAAP, which is the only maritime academy among the 14 national finalists, represented Region III after winning the Regional Best Student Services Program including the Best in Development and Welfare and Best in Community and Research Development Program.
