## **EVALUATION REPORT ON THE NI Ph BRANCH EVENT 2022**

This report presents the feedback of the participants of the NI event in celebration of the 50<sup>th</sup> NI founding anniversary conducted by the NI Ph branch in collaboration with MAAP, AMOSUP, IMarEST Ph branch, and other partners on November 18, 2022 at the AMOSUP Convention Hall, Intramuros, Manila. The event's theme is "Maritime Leadership in the Changing World." About 30% or 22 of the 74 participants were able to respond Google evaluation survey form just after the activity.

As a whole, the participating NI members and other friends from the maritime industry were very much satisfied with the said event. Table 1 displays the feedback of the participants on various aspects of the program.

As gleaned from Table 1, the respondents considered the objectives of the event to be achieved very satisfactorily (mean = 4.59, SD =.59). They considered the event to be very much acceptable/beneficial to them, and the event provided the attendees an opportunity for fellowship.

Regarding the administrative aspect of the activities, the venue ranked first. The venue is followed by food and facilities. Overall, the participants were very satisfied with the administration of the event (mean = 4.55, SD= 0.56).

With respect to the program, the participants were very satisfied, as suggested by the mean of 4.56 with a standard deviation of 0.68. Fellowship among participants topped the criteria for this aspect of the evaluation.

Overall, the participants were very satisfied with the event, as suggested by the overall mean of 4.62 with standard deviation of 0.61.
