After we receive your application form you will receive an email notification of acceptance of your application (and your abstract if so submitted), and then when you come to the conference registration desk please pay the registration fee.

The **registration fee** is 3,500 Thai Baht in cash (or USD 100), and includes lunch and snack breaks for all five days, and a participation certificate (issued at the end of the conference). Current ABA Board members are exempt from the registration fee. The conference dinner fee is 1,500 Thai Baht to be held on 25 March (Optional). The group city sightseeing tour on 28 March will be a separate cost (inexpensive options will be included).

Although the conference can be joined via group Skype, we are not accepting applications for **online presentation**.

Accommodation: Participants are asked to arrange for their own accommodation. Those who would like to stay at the Pathumwan Princess Hotel please contact the hotel directly. More information will be provided about the discount possibility at the hotel for conference participants.
