Dr. Baylon was honored to participate in the Presidents' Forum at the International Association of Maritime Universities (IAMU) Annual General Assembly 2025, hosted by AMET University, India. Representing MAAP, she joined colleagues from the five other MET universities—from Finland, Norway, Colombia, Belgium, and Croatia.





The assembly brought together over 140 participants from 38 countries, including the USA, Poland, Korea, Turkey, Vietnam, Indonesia, Japan, India, Georgia, Australia, Romania, China, Montenegro, Slovenia, Jamaica, Spain, Ukraine, Bulgaria, Croatia, Egypt, the UK, Sweden, and more. The Philippines was represented by three delegates from MAAP (Vicente Juan Torio, Jeric Bacasdoon, and Dr. Baylon) and five from JBLMU, led by Capt. Luis Evidente.



Of the 50 project proposals submitted by senior researchers, only four were approved for funding. Congratulations to CMU Romania, led by Dr. Cristina Dragomir, with Dr. Angelica Baylon from MAAP (Philippines) and Dr. Sanja Bauk from EMERA Estonia as project partners. For junior researchers, three proposals were considered, including the approved project by Mao Tze Matillano Bayotas of MAAP, as project proponent.
